

PHASED REINTEGRATION PLAN

Reintegrating our community one step at a time

PHASE 1

State & local guidance allows reopening

Safety Precaution:

- Masks & other PPE as required
- Shelter and socialize within zone
- Observe social distancing
- Hand hygiene & infection control practices with added sanitation zones
- Continued health screenings

-
- Visits behind closed windows, online or during scheduled outdoor visiting hours
 - Salons will reopen (where available)
 - Special outdoor events by zone
 - Walking groups by zone
 - Scheduled outdoor visits during visiting hours
 - Hallway events and dining
 - Virtual events
 - Healthcare professional visits will resume as needed
 - Scheduled essential healthcare transportation resumes
 - New move-ins can occur with 14-day safeguards & shelter in zone commitment
 - Future residents can visit for virtual and window tours in designated area (limit only one visitor at a time)

PHASE 2

Projected new cases of COVID-19 fall below 1 per 1 million

Safety Precaution:

- Masks & other PPE as required
- Shelter and socialize within zone
- Observe social distancing
- Hand hygiene & infection control practices
- Continued health screenings

- Visiting hours expanded
 - Salons will reopen (where available)
 - Restaurant dining by zone with take-out offered
 - Small group events by zone
 - Common area use by zone
 - Fitness center use by zone
 - Outdoor entertainment and special events by zone
 - Employment interviews onsite

PHASE 3

Estimated 56 days after start of Phase 1

Safety Precaution:

- Masks & other PPE as required
- Observe social distancing
- Hand hygiene & infection control practices
- Continued health screenings

- Visiting hours expanded to offer outdoor visits
 - Live entertainment schedule resumes
 - Restaurant dining with reduced seating capacity and take-out offered
 - Small group events with limited seating
 - Common area use with limited seating
 - Scheduled transportation to area conveniences begins
 - Resident driving encouraged to remain limited
 - Future resident tours resume with some restrictions

PHASE 4

End of the COVID-19 pandemic

- All normal business resumes
- Visitation resumes with no restrictions
- Future resident tours resume with no restrictions
- All events resume with no restrictions
- Signing in/out screening resumes to normal process

The phased reintegration plan is subject to change based on local, state and federal guidelines, current community exposure risk and improved practices. It is our goal to open as quickly and safely as possible. However, if new or increased risk is identified, the community may revert to any prior phase or reimplement restrictions.
