


COVID-19 VACCINE ACCESS TIMELINE

WHAT CAN YOU DO TO PREPARE FOR THE COVID-19 VACCINE?

MAKE YOUR DECISION ABOUT THE VACCINE.

Review the vaccine and know the side effects. The side effects observed in the trials include pain at the injection site (the arm), fever, chills, headache, fatigue, and muscle and joint aches. These side effects reportedly lasted up to one and a half days and were at times intense.

WE MUST ACT QUICKLY.

We expect to administer all doses we get during this first wave within 10 days of receiving them. Things will move very quickly. The vaccine will have the greatest impact with the passage of time and with enough people taking it. We strongly recommend that you get vaccinated, although we will not be requiring it.

WHAT IF YOU HAVE ALREADY HAD COVID-19?

We still strongly encourage you to get the vaccine. Not enough is known yet about the immunity that people will have after experiencing a COVID-19 infection, and whether they can be reinfected. Therefore, it is still recommended that those individuals get vaccinated.
